



Achim D. Gruber graduated from the Hannover Vet School (TiHo) in 1991. Graduate training resulted in a Dr. med. vet. degree (1994, TiHo) and a Ph.D. degree in Cancer Biology (1998, Cornell University, NY). He was nationally as well as European College of Veterinary Pathologists (ECVP) board certified in 2001. After a professorship in molecular pathology at TiHo University (2003-2004) he was appointed as Chair at the Dept. of Veterinary Pathology at Freie Universität Berlin (2004). His main research interests include molecular pathology, cancer biology, CLCA genes, innate mucosal immunity and digital image analysis. The Gruber lab is widely funded by the German National Research Foundation (DFG) and various other sources. He published > 300 original research papers and trained > 60 junior pathologists and graduate students. He held various positions in the European Society of Veterinary Pathology (ESVP) and the College (ECVP). Since 2013, he serves as Associate Dean of Research at the Berlin vet school.
