Short Bio:

Dr. Nick Robinson is a veterinary anatomic pathologist at the Cummings School of Veterinary Medicine at Tufts University, USA. He has a diverse background that includes diagnostic pathology, lab animal pathology and medical device pathology. He has been involved in academia since 2004 in various capacities, but is currently the section head of pathology, director of the clinical pathology lab and chair of the Department of Biomedical Sciences. While his main interest area is diagnostic pathology of all species, the large case load at the Cummings School sees numerous oncology cases of dogs and cats along with a busy soft tissue surgery, gastrointestinal, ophthalmic, hepatologic and dermatologic case load. In addition to the diagnostic pathology case load, he teaches in the didactic and rotation portions of the DVM program along with mentoring 3 anatomic pathology residents. Dr. Robinson's current research profile includes the investigation of cardiac toxicity of doxorubicin in dogs and the chemokine signatures in T cell mediated canine skin disorders.
